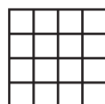
Here, nature abandons the smooth gesture of a single brushstroke and instead builds in fragments. A mosaic born of ancient fracture and time's slow fusion, where each broken piece finds its place in the whole.

Breccia Romaine reveals its character through chaos held in balance: charcoal and dove grays collide with fields of white, softened by taupe. Rust veining threads through every seam, occasionally blooming into soft pink, giving the stone an almost terrazzo-like rhythm that's organic, unrepeatable, and full of movement.

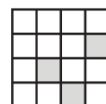
